Description:

The Campaign Cabinet provides volunteer leadership to the campaign. Cabinet members will have a strong commitment to State College of Florida and to its mission; have a broad network of friends and business associates from which to draw additional volunteers and donors; are willing to use their position and influence on behalf of the campaign; and will offer time, attention and financial support to the campaign.

Responsibilities:

The time commitment will be over the next 12-18 months. The following is a list of responsibilities:

- Make personal and/or corporate pledges proportionate to his/her financial ability;
- Guide the overall campaign, making recommendations and decisions regarding campaign issues;
- Identify, cultivate and solicit prospective donors;
- Assist with the prospect review and discussions;
- Promote and maintain enthusiasm throughout the entire campaign;
- Attend Cabinet meetings on a monthly basis and major campaign events;
- Advocate for State College of Florida and the success of the campaign.

Skills:

Cabinet members will be active listeners, asking good questions and exercising sound judgment in meeting with prospects and donors. Cabinet members will have experience asking for financial support and/or are willing to be trained to solicit. Cabinet members will be good storytellers to share examples of the impact State College of Florida has in the community and will seek appropriate examples to match prospect/donor interests.
